## REGAN WEIDNER WINS PRINCETON INVITE

Coming out party

PRINCETON — Welcome to high school, Regan Weidner. After the Bureau Valley freshman won the IESA Class 8A 1,600-meter state title last spring and has run past most of the competition this fall, Weidner had her unofficial coming out party on Saturday.

In her first big local meet, the Storm runner easily outran the competition and bested a deep field in Saturday's Princeton Invitational. On the 2.98-mile course, Weidner ran a winning time of 18:41.29 seconds, which was 13.47 seconds ahead of the field and 48.21 seconds better than the former meet record of 19:29.50. Not bad for someone who hadn't run a cross country race until two and a half weeks ago.

"I wasn't even going to run cross country at beginning of my eighth-grade year," said Weidner, who won her first big meet Sept. 3 at the Oregon Invitational. "I had no interest in it, but then I won state in the mile so that changed my mind pretty easily."

Unlike Tuesday when she finished second in a four-team meet, Weidner didn't go out too fast and instead stayed with the pack as she waited for the opportunity to strike. Finally, nearly two miles into the race, Weidner kicked and broke free of the field to claim the win in record-breaking time. "I had no idea. I just went," Weidner said of the record. "I had no idea that I was going to break it, or that I was even close to breaking it. Actually, breaking it makes this pretty cool."

Thanks to Weidner's winning pace, a total of five runners bettered the meet record, which was set in last year's race by Annawan-Wethersfield's Nicole Wager on a 3-mile course. Those runners included Fieldcrest's Maria Baldwin (18:54.76), Mercer County's Miranda Biddle (18:59.84), Sherrard's Robbie Hoye (19:00.07) and Hall's Liz Mosbach (19:02.26). Weidner's senior BV teammate Kimi Sanden was sixth with a time of 19:35.18.

Baldwin, who had run against Weidner during 5Ks in the summer, managed to stay with the Storm freshman for longer than anyone else but could not keep pace. "I knew I would be in the lead pack and I wanted to make a move on her later on, but she made her move first and that's just how it goes," Baldwin said. Still, the second-place finish was one place higher than the sophomore's third-place finish at last year's meet, and her time of 18:54.76 was 39.4 seconds ahead of her pace last season. "I think things went pretty well," Baldwin said. "I would have liked to get an invite win, but Regan is such a great runner. She ran so well, and I am glad I placed second."

Mosbach set the pace for the first half of the run, but fell back over the final mile. Despite dropping, the Lady Red Devil senior finished fifth and bettered her 2010 Princeton Invitational time by nearly 33.5 seconds. "It feels nice to be where I am at right now," said Mosbach, who won the Princeton Invitational in 2009. "I wish I would have done better place-wise, but I feel good about my time."

Weidner and Sanden helped BV to 80 team points, which was third behind champion Rock Falls (50) and Mercer County (77). Hall (91) was fourth, Fieldcrest (163) fifth, Princeton (188) seventh, Mendota (235) eighth and La Salle-Peru (240) ninth. Also finishing in the top 20 of the 94-runner race was Hall's Katie Hoffert (12th, 20:23.99) and Princeton's C.J. Rhodes (16th, 20:38.27).

## DERICK JOHNSON, BUREAU VALLEY STORM TAKE HOME CHAMPIONSHIP

PRINCETON — Bureau Valley's Derrick Johnson ran two races at Saturday's Princeton Invitational. After the Storm senior ran past the field to win the boys race by nearly 22 seconds, Johnson turned back around and raced to the finishing chute where he was front and center to cheer on his teammates as they neared the finish line.

"Right now, we always say these meets don't matter, but confidence-wise these meets do matter," Johnson said. "Last year that might have been a little bit of our problem was confidence, so to come in here and do what we did, I wanted to see everyone run."

The extra motivation must have worked. Led by Johnson's win and a third-place finish from sophomore Ryan Taylor, Bureau Valley finished with 82 team points to edge runner-up and Three Rivers Conference foe Sterling Newman (85).

"We are all about the team," BV coach Dale Donner said. "We would much rather see a team get a plaque than an individual get medals. When Derrick came over after he ran, he was more excited about the team winning than him winning the race." After finishing third in last year's Princeton Invitational, Johnson stayed with the pack for the first half of the race before breaking loose midway through.

He steadily and consistently opened up his lead as he finished with a winning time of 15:41.59, which was two seconds off the meet record but 22.36 seconds ahead of Mercer County's Sam Whan, who posted a second-place time of 16:03.95. "As far as about me, I didn't care as much about my time. I was more concerned with winning," said Johnson, who won his first career Princeton Invitational. "I put in a surge (about midway through) to put about 10 to 15 meters on everyone, and after that, I started distancing myself."

Taylor wasn't too far behind his teammate as the Storm runner ran a 16:18.20 to place third narrowly ahead of Amboy-LaMoille's Colton Shaw (16:18.76). "Ryan Taylor stepped up to get third place, and that was big for us," Donner said. "We saw where he ran last week with Colton Shaw (at the Oregon Invitational); he ended up beating him here and last week he was 200 meters behind him. We are very excited for him."

La Salle-Peru senior Vincent Walker rounded out the top five as the senior ran a time of 16:25.26. "I had never broken 17 minutes before — my previous P.R. was 17:14 — so my whole goal was just to break 16:59," Walker said. "I am extremely happy with how I did." Walker hung with the lead pack for the first half of the race and kept Johnson in his sights, which allowed him to push himself and get to his goal of going under 17 minutes. "I put in a lot of miles this summer and winter, and I really wanted to do well in my last season," Walker said.

Behind BV and Newman, Amboy-LaMoille scored 177 team points to finish seventh. Mendota (183) was eighth, La Salle-Peru (185) was ninth, St. Bede (325) was 12th and Fieldcrest (351) was 13th.

Other individual competitors placing in the top 20 included Princeton's Zach Holmbeck (eighth, 16:39.80); Mendota's Ethan Sack (12th, 16:52.92) and Adam Morris (19th, 17:26.54) and Bureau Valley's Ryan Johnson (14th, 16:59.74).
